
SIGNALS IN SEMAPHORE

If you don't have a computer or a phone, how do you communicate with people? On Adventure Island, you can't even send letters, because there isn't a postal system! So, let's learn about another type of message... Semaphore!

Semaphore was an earlier version of a telegram, with messages being sent like a relay along a set of watch towers, or from boat to boat. By using your arms (Usually with flags to make them easier to see from far away) you didn't have to worry about not hearing each other, and could even view signals through binoculars or a telescope.

There's a pose for every letter of the alphabet (which you can see at the bottom of the worksheet!) so **try spelling out a message**. With semaphore it's important to strike each pose with strength and confidence, and to keep each message short and to the point! Can you decipher our message below?
